The condition for the enrollment is the successful graduation of the 2nd year of studies.

Vsebina:

Vsebina predmeta vključuje tako poznavanje vseh vplivnih filozofskih šol kitajske tradicije in idejnega razvoja njihovih osrednjih predstavnikov, kot tudi poznavanje metodološke specifike kitajske teoretske misli. Pri tem je poudarek na razumevanju konceptov immanentne metafizike, načela komplementarnosti, strukturne povezanosti narave in družbe, ter prehoda od holističnih diskurzov k zametkom dualistične misli. Vsebina se posreduje skozi optiko specifike starokitajske etike in njene povezave s kulturo in družbo. Vsebina predmeta pa zaobjema tudi tiste elemente klasične kitajske miselnosti, ki (zaradi specifičnih ekonomsko – političnih pogojev razvoja tradicionalne Kitajske) v teku zgodovinskega razvoja kitajske tradicije niso prevladali kot osrednji metodološki ali ideološki

Content (Syllabus outline):

The contents include the introduction of all influential philosophical schools of the Chinese tradition and the theoretical development visible from the works of their most important representatives, as well as the mastering of the methodological specifics of the Chinese philosophical thought. In this context, the focus is on the understanding of the concepts of immanent transcendence, the principle of complementarity, the structural connection of nature and society, and the transition from the holistic thought to the germs of dualistic thought. The contents are being transmitted through the lens of the specific features of classical Chinese ethics and its connections with the culture and society. The contents also include those elements of the classical Chinese thought that have – due to specific economic and political circumstances of traditional China – not prevailed as central methodological or ideological

discourses. In this context, the subject is mainly dealing with proto-scientific methodologies and traditional Chinese logic. A half of the course is centered on the analysis of primary sources in Chinese.

Cilji in kompetence:

Uvid v specifiko tradicionalnih kitajskih konceptov in kategorij, poznavanje in sposobnost umestitve posamičnih filozofskih šol v kontekst splošnega razvoja kitajske filozofije.
Poznavanje razvoja in sposobnost konkretnih interpretacij besedil klasične kitajske filozofije ter sposobnost umeščanja osrednjih dosežkov kitajske idejne tradicije v kontekst svetovne filozofije.
Spoznavanje in ponoranje osnovnih struktur klasične kitajščine, ki se pojavljajo v filozofskih besedilih.

Objectives and competences:

The subject offers an insight into the specific features of traditional Chinese concepts and categories, the knowledge and the ability of positioning particular philosophic schools into the context of general development of Chinese philosophy. It also includes insights into the development of classical Chinese philosophy; the students obtain the ability to interpret the texts belonging to the Chinese philosophical tradition and to position them into the context of world philosophy. Students become familiar with the main structures in classical Chinese that appear in the philosophical texts.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Sposobnost razumevanja specifike starokitajskih teoretskih diskurzov in kritičnega prevpraševanja ter preseganja evropocentričnih interpretacij; sposobnost umestitve kitajskih filozofskih trendov v kontekste svetovne filozofije in sposobnost primerjalne analize. Študentje in študentke se seznanijo s posebnostmi diskurzov kitajske idejne tradicije, s tradicionalnimi koncepti in s specifiko kategorialnega aparata kitajske filozofije. Osvojijo pregledno znanje razvoja kitajske filozofske misli od obdobja antike do pričetka kitajske novoveške miselnosti, t.j. vključno do razvoja neokonfucijskih diskurzov dinastije Song. Poseben poudarek je tudi na poznavanju in razumevanju aksioloških, logičnih in aksioloških elementov starokitajske tradicije.

Intended learning outcomes:

The ability to understand specific features of the ancient Chinese theoretical discourses and the critical questioning and transcending Eurocentric interpretations; the ability to position the Chinese philosophic trends into the contexts of global philosophy, and the ability to perform comparative analyses. The students gain an insight into the specific features of the Chinese intellectual tradition, traditional concepts and the specificities of the categorical apparatus of Chinese philosophy. They gain an overview knowledge about the development of Chinese philosophical thought from ancient times till the beginning of the Chinese new era, i.e. including the development of the neo-Confucian thought of

the Song Dynasty. A special focus is also on the mastering and understanding of axiological, logical and epistemological elements within the Chinese intellectual tradition.

The students are able to read the selected philosophical texts and explain the structures that appear in them. They are able to apply this understanding to other contemporary texts.

Metode poučevanja in učenja:

Polovico vsake ure predstavlja predavanje ex-katedra, drugi del pa je zastavljen interaktivno oziroma dialoško. Predavatelj/ica vsakokrat pripravi vrsto problemskih sklopov, ki izhajajo iz predavanj in iz študijske literature, in katere morajo študentje in študentke obdelati v procesu aktivnega vključevanja v pouk. Pri tem je osrednja naloga predavatelja/predavateljice, da debato in problematizacijo vodi tako, da bodo študentje in študentke skozi lastne formulacije razumeli in osvojili prej navedene temeljne vsebinske cilje in kompetence. Seminarski del predmeta predstavlja natančna struktturna in vsebinska analiza in interpretacija izbranih filozofskih del, ki obsega individualno in skupinsko delo ter diskusije.

Learning and teaching methods:

The course is carried out throughout the entire academic year. It is a combination of classical ex-cathedra lectures and an interactive or polylogue part. Each time, the teacher prepares a number of problem scopes, which are derived from the lectures and the obligatory study literature, which has to be studied by the students in advance. This questions and problems are debated and integrated into the study process, in which the students are actively participating. In this sense, the crucial task of the teacher is to lead the debate and the problematizing in a manner that allows the students to understand and to master the abovementioned basic contents and thus to gain the above stated goals and competences through their own formulations. The seminar part is focused on text analysis and interpretation, which includes individual and group work as well as discussions.
